Student Dress Code

What is a modest fit? Modest fit is clothing that fits and covers while not being too big or too small/short.

Tops:

- Collared shirt-Any color or pattern-Must be a modest fit and be <u>tucked</u> in at the waist.
- Orangewood t-shirt-Must be tucked in at the waist. May be purchased in the front office.
- NOT PERMITTED: T-shirts or other shirts may not be worn over collared shirts.
- Jackets/sweaters/vests/hoodies may not substitute for a collared shirt.
- See through or transparent clothing and shirts with less than 3 finger width straps or sleeves are not permitted.

Bottoms:

- Pants/Jeans-Must be fastened at the waist. If bottoms fall off of the waist, a belt must be worn.
- Shorts/Skirts-Must be fastened at the waist. If bottoms fall off of the waist, a belt must be worn.
- Shorts/Skirts must be a modest fit and AT LEAST FINGERTIP LENGTH.
- Dresses-must be a modest fit and AT LEAST FINGERTIP LENGTH. Girls should wear shorts or leggings under their dresses at all times.
- NOT PERMITTED: Ripped, torn, or faux tears in clothing,

Cold Weather:

- Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts-Must be a modest fit.
- Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts may NOT be worn out of the classroom unless the weather dictates the need.
- NOT PERMITTED: Oversized jackets/sweatshirts/hoodies.

Shoes:

- Sneakers must be worn with socks at all times-NO EXCEPTIONS.
- NOT PERMITTED: Boat shoes (Sperry or other brand), knee high sneakers, shoes with wheels, boots, sandals, crocs or flip flops.

Jewelry/Makeup

- Any articles of clothing or jewelry that could likely cause injury such as dangling earnings, excessive jewelry, chokers,
 dog collars, spikes, chain wallets are not permitted. Prohibited adornments (piercings) include, but are not limited to,
 hoops or rings attached to the nose, eyebrow, cheeks, or lip.
- Only 1 bracelet per arm allowed.
- No tattoos.
- No Fake or press on nails. Nails should be the natural nail.

Hair and Head Wear

Student hair color/dye is limited to any naturally occurring color. Extreme, distracting hair styles and haircuts including Mohawk's, edging or designs cut into the hair are <u>not acceptable</u>. Bandanas, sweatbands, scarves and hats are not permitted with the exception of hats for outdoor activities.

- Other
- Rolling Backpacks are not permitted.
- Pajama attire of any kind is not permitted.
- Long coats, including trench coats are not permitted inside the building.
- Blankets, pillows, gloves and/or stuffed animals are not appropriate for school.

Any article of clothing, jewelry or accessory, which in the judgment of school administration is a distraction or hindrance to classroom learning and/or activities or poses a safety hazard, can be forbidden at the discretion of Administration without prior warning.
